- The switch for changing the direction of rotation may only be operated by authorised specialists. The direction of rotation must not in particular be reversed in a frost protection circuit.

- The device contains electrical and electronic components and is not allowed to be disposed of as household refuse. All locally valid regulations and requirements must be observed.

Product features

Principle of operation The

The actuator is connected with a standard modulating signal of DC 0...10V and travels to the position defined by the positioning signal. Measuring voltage U serves for the electrical display of the valve position 0...100% and as slave control signal for other actuators.

Parameterisable actuators

The factory settings cover the most common applications. Input and output signals and other parameters can be altered with the PC-Tool MFT-P or with the Service tool ZTH FU.

Simple direct mounting

Simple direct mounting on the butterfly valve. The mounting orientation in relation to the butterfly valve can be selected in 90° (angle) increments.

Manual override

Manual override with push-button possible (the gear is disengaged for as long as the button is pressed or remains locked).

High functional reliability

The actuator is overload protected, requires no limit switches and automatically stops when the end stop is reached.

Adjustable angle of rotation Combination valve/actuator

Adjustable angle of rotation with mechanical end stops.

For valves with the following mechanical specifications in accordance with ISO 5211 F07:

- Square stem head SW = 17 mm for form fit coupling of the rotary actuator.

- Hole circle d = 70 mm

Home position

The first time the supply voltage is switched on, i.e. at the time of commissioning, the actuator carries out an adaption, which is when the operating range and position feedback adjust themselves to the mechanical setting range.

The actuator then moves into the position defined by the positioning signal. Factory setting: Y2 (counter-clockwise rotation).

Adaption and synchronisation

An adaption can be triggered manually by pressing the "Adaption" button or with the PC-Tool. Both mechanical end stops are detected during the adaption (entire setting range).

Automatic synchronisation after pressing the gearbox disengagement button is configured. The synchronisation is in the home position (0%).

The actuator then moves into the position defined by the positioning signal.

A range of settings can be adapted using the PC-Tool (see MFT-P documentation)



AC/DC 24 V, modulating








Override control with AC 24 V with rotary switch











Follow-up control (position-dependent)








Control with 4...20 mA via external resistor






Caution:

The 500 Ω resistor converts the 4...20 mA current signal to a voltage signal DC 2...10 V




(1) Adapting the direction of rotation


Procedure

- 1. Connect 24V to connections 1 and 2
- 2. Disconnect connection 3:
- with direction of rotation Y1:
- Actuator rotates to the left
- with direction of rotation Y2
- Actuator rotates to the right
- 3. Short-circuit connections 2 and 3: - Actuator runs in opposite direction
- Functions for actuators with specific parameters (Parametrisation with PC-Tool necessary)

Override control and limiting with AC 24 V with rotary switch









Operating controls and indicators



1 Direction of rotation switch

Switch over: Direction of rotation changes

2 Push-button and LED display green

Off: No power supply or malfunction

On: In operation

Press button: Triggers angle of rotation adaptation, followed by standard mode

3 Push-button and LED display yellow

Off: Standard mode

On: Adaptation or synchronising process active

Press button: No function

4 Gear disengagement button

Press button: Gear disengages, motor stops, manual override possible

Release button: Gear engages, synchronisation starts, followed by standard mode

5 Service plug

For connecting parameterisation and service tools

Check power supply connection

2 Off and 3 On Possible wiring error in power supply






